Council discussed their interest in the Special Focus Areas for 2022.

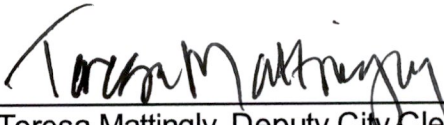
