Review of Tuesday, April 11, 2017 Minutes: The April 11, 2017 minutes were moved for approval.

Old Business:

- **Memorial Day** – Everything was ready on time and the weather was beautiful. The cemetery didn't have as many visitors as previous years but Monday morning had a good amount of people. The sound system was hard to hear and didn't work as good as planned. Planning to look for a better one next year. There were a couple complains about the line trimming because it was too short.

New Business:

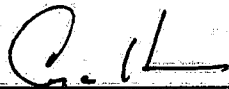
