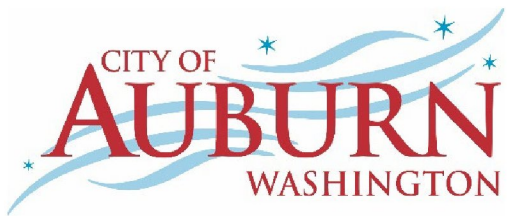

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I. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Menzia called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m.

Members present: Chair Waylon Menzia, Vice Chair Jonathan Mulenga, Member Savannah Lueck, Member Janine Park, and Member Briseyda Sandate.

Staff present: Deputy Mayor James Jeyaraj, and Director of Administration Dana Hinman.

II. ANNOUNCEMENTS – There were no announcements.

III. AGENDA MODIFICATIONS – There were no agenda modifications.

IV. CONSENT AGENDA
