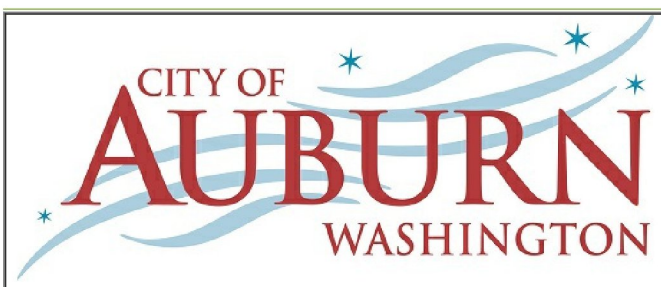

iii. AJCC would also be involved in the decision making process on how to distribute the funds

D. Update from Deputy Mayor James Jeyaraj

i. DM Jeyaraj reported that the City Council, Mayor and staff visited Olympia to visit with legislators and learn about the issues facing the current legislative session.

ii. AJCC Advisory Board: Member Helms volunteered to bring the idea to groups at Auburn High School. Chair Menzia reminded the AJCC to recruit new members to replace the four members that are aging out of the AJCC.

iii. The AJCC has a desire to interview potential members to put forward as nominees to the Mayor and for approval by the Auburn City Council.
