The Junior Council had a conference call with Sarah Foudy, Campaign Director for The Bully Project. The Bully Project is a nationwide movement to end bullying in America, inspired by the award-winning film BULLY. The Bully Project was created to help prepare educators to lead discussions with their students that focus on developing empathy and taking action. To date, the campaign has

facilitated screenings for over 250,000 students and 7,500 educators across 120+ cities.

Sarah Foudy gave the Junior Council an overview on The Bully Project and gave them ideas on how to incorporate it in the Auburn community. Some ideas included integrating The Bully Project with Auburn's DARE programs, churches, youth leadership programs, and Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts of America.
