## The Auburn Community & Event Center at the Les Gove Community Campus

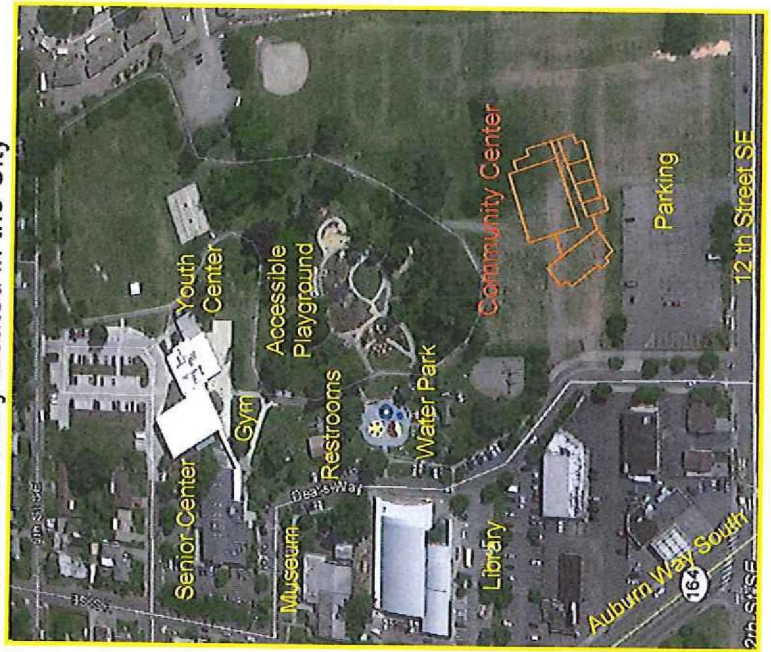


View from the Park
