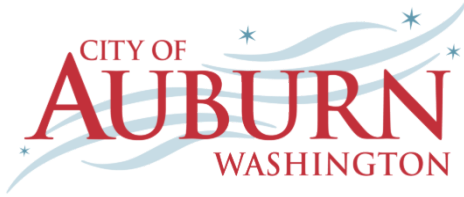

Chair Lawand Muhsen called the meeting to order at 7:02PM.

Hakima Abdikadir mentioned that the council should avoid using mountain motifs in the Auburn Junior City Council logo as she feels it is overdone. She likes the background of logo number 5 and number 1, with a strong preference for number 1.

Lawand Muhsen liked the mountain motifs and suggested they add the color red to the logo.

Makaela Pedraja liked the Auburn font.

The council stated that they like minimalistic designs, suggested adding a surrounding border, did not want stars or triangle shapes, and didn't want a white outline on the logos.

The logo votes are as follows:

- Logos 2, 3, 6, 8, 10, 12, 13 and 14: 0 votes.
- Logos 4, 11, and 15: 1 vote.
- Logos 1 and 9: 3 votes.
- Logo 5: 5 votes.
- Logo 7: 9 votes.

- A. AJCC to discuss logo and branding ideas and vote on direction for the designer.
